



Constituencies of the CDI

To ensure that the range of kinds of career development practice, and the diversity of delivery systems across the UK are properly represented, the membership is divided into "constituencies".

On joining, each member selects one professional constituency and one national constituency in which they will vote.

This choice does not limit the activities which any individual member can engage with, and there will be a range of other groups and fora for members to join in. The constituencies are:

The **professional constituencies** are:

Careers Education	Those working primarily in careers education, in schools, further education and skills institutions, and in higher education.
Career Guidance and Career Coaching	Those working in career guidance with young people and/or adults
Career Consultancy and Career Coaching	Those working with adults and organisations mostly in the private sector

The **national constituencies** are:

- England
- Scotland
- Wales
- Northern Ireland
