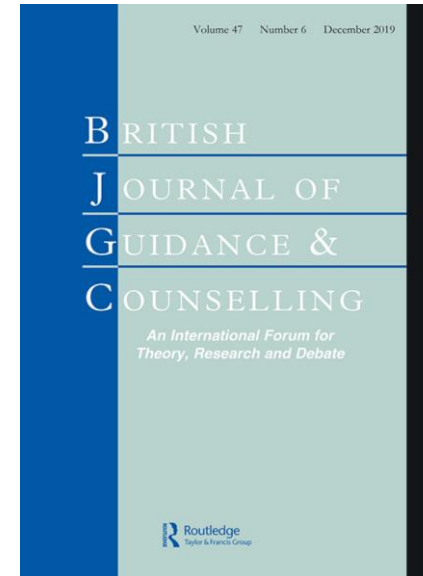
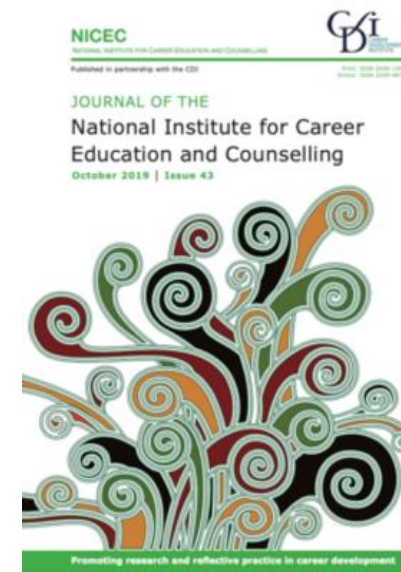
CAREER DECISIONS AND SOCIAL JUSTICE
