

Qualification in Career Development Student Destination Figures 2020

Introduction

This report covers those full time and part-time QCD students who completed their qualification in 2020.

Summary of QCD Student Destinations 2020

Employed/Seeking Work

Compared to 2019 the number of students finding employment increased by 1% to 93%.

The number of students actively seeking work increased by 2% to 5% and the number of students not actively seeking work stayed the same at 2%.

Career Development Roles

Of the 128 students, 56 studied at either Edinburgh Napier University or the University of the West of Scotland and 41 found work with Skills Development Scotland (SDS). Some students having being employed by SDS whilst they undertook the qualification on a part-time basis.

One student found employment with the Careers Service in Northern Ireland.

The number of students finding work in secondary education increased from 13% to 25%. Those finding work in FE/6th Form Colleges decreased from 8% to 4%. The number of students finding work with local authorities remained the same at 2%.

Those finding work in HE institutions increased from 14% to 19%. One student who completed in 2020 found work with the National Careers Service.

The percentage finding employment in other voluntary sector guidance increased from 1% to 6 %. Private sector guidance decreased from 2% to 1 % The number finding work abroad increased from 1 % to 2%. 6% of students found work in the charities sector and social enterprises.

Non-Career Development Roles

8% of students completing in 2020 found work in a non-career guidance role, an increase of 7%

One student continued to further study in a career development subject and one in non-career related area.
