




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Careers provision at Aquinas College

- Mixture of both strategy and operational responsibilities.
- Developing the strategic approach for the academic year for Year 12 & 13 students.
- Evaluating progress of Gatsby Benchmarks with Enterprise Coordinator/Adviser.
- Overseeing the college's progress towards the Quality in Careers Standard Award.

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What my role involves - Careers Adviser

- Arranging 1-1 career appointments may also involve parents/carers attending sessions.
- Creating social media content to promote career opportunities for students, staff and parents/carers.
- Supporting our pastoral team, should issues arise with students who are considering alternative options.

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What my role involves - Personal Tutor

- Personal tutor to Year 12 and Year 13 students (up to 60 students).
- Support students through their tutorial programmes - from careers, academic independent learning skills, to equality and diversity and health awareness issues.
- Support with progression 'after Aquinas'
